1) Vendor Finance.

The Licensee agrees, they are indebted to Spray Pave the sum as circled on the payment plan, of page 2/5. **Total E.P.P. amount column.** This sum includes all interest and shall be paid as per agreement. EPP payments are not conditional upon business income.

2) Dates for payment.

The EPP deposits and 1st EPP payment are due on the page 2/5 dates. All payments are due the first day of each month thereafter, until total debt is paid in full.

3) Payment received late, administration fee.

If a payment is received late.

- a) A \$100 administration fee represents the reasonable cost of following up and accommodating the late payment. Which is added to the total debt.
- b) An interest rate of 12% (1% per month) is also added to the total debt, which compounds monthly.

4) Acceleration of payments.

If there are 2 payment defaults. (Which may not be consecutive) a) The total balance of all sums are to be paid without notice and become immediately due and owing and be immediately recoverable as a debt. b) In the event that SPA exercises its payment recovery rights, the Licensee shall not be entitled to any discounts as otherwise offered.

5) Costs of Default.

The Licensee shall pay Spray Pave’s legal and all other costs caused by the Licensee’s default under this agreement on a full indemnity basis.

6) Variation of E.P.P. schedule or fees.

Should Licensee request a variation to either reduce the monthly amount or an addition to the 12 payments per year. (Ie weekly or fortnightly) The Licensee also accepts an extra administration fee of \$22.00 per reduced or extra transaction, to accommodate the extra administration, which shall be added to the total debt owed. If such a request is approved, it would not affect any other clause or the entirety of this agreement.

7) Accepting all Business License conditions.

The [Confirming The Details \(C.T.D.\) pages 4 and 5](#) is a continuation of this vendor finance agreement and outlines both parties business operation obligations. Licensee’s signature/s below confirm they have fully read with full understanding and offer their free and willing acceptance towards [pages 4 and 5 of C.T.D.](#)

8) Signatory offers personal guarantee for Company, Trust or any other entity application.

9) Charge to SPA (and / or Assignee)

If the Licensee defaults in 2 payments. (Which may not be consecutive), they charge in favour of SPA all their present and or future property. The property whether real or personal, including property described in the E.P.P. application, or any other property, shall be included into any other rights of SPA under this agreement. SPA is entitled to lodge a caveat against any property registered in the name of the Licensee/s to protect SPA’s interest.

10) Representation.

Licensee confirms that the only and total representation they have relied upon, was a combination of all written material by SPA. Ie:- Web site, Advertising, E.P.P. and [C.T.D.](#) Plus their own independent research. Any verbal representation is only a repeat of SPA written material.

11) Legal and financial advice.

Licensee confirms they have sought independent legal advice and/or financial advice regarding their own personal suitability towards all business license contract aspects or has self-elected not to seek any such advice.

12) Severance

If any provision in this agreement or any other documents be or become invalid, illegal or unenforceable, that provision shall be severed from said document, without effect to remaining provisions.

13) Assignment by Licensee.

The Licensee rights of this agreement may be assigned to another similarly secure party after a new EPP application sent to SPA, which shall not be unreasonably withheld.

14) Assignment and account management by Spray Pave

[AAA Mercantile](#) act as account receivable managers for the EPP payments. In case of Licensee default, SPA reserves the right to assign the total balance amount, comprising principal and interest, under this agreement as a debt for collection to AAA Mercantile or a similar firm.

15) Dispute resolution.

16) Exclusive Jurisdiction to South Australia. (SA)

Both parties freely submit themselves to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of (SA) and the exclusion of any other state or territory courts. In respect of disputes whether under the contract or in respect of the contract. Any actions arising shall be instituted, heard and determined only in a court of Adelaide, South Australia.

17) Joint and several liability.

Where the Licensee constitutes more than one person. Each such person will be jointly and severally liable for all amounts payable under this agreement.
